We are responding directly to your Thursday 2/25/2010 10:21 AM email re ESPA Comprehensive Aquifer Management Plan.

We have previously pointed out flaws in the CAMP document, through personal communication and by legal counsel.

The issues are large and complex, and from our standpoint, require more than the simple "Yes" or "No" vote in your email.

We support the restoration of the Rule of Law, i.e. the prior appropriation doctrine, the preservation of the value of private property water rights as expressed in the constitutional right of prior appropriation, and the conservation of the aquifer as a public resource through the implementation of the prior appropriation doctrine.

Therefore, we support the concept of CAMP as originally envisioned, but not CAMP as currently drafted and implemented by IDWR.
