Intended crops are grains, potatoes and beets. Average annual water demand should be 12 to 14 inches per acre with a peak demand on beets to be 18 to 20 inches per acre. The lava area is quite solid and would be defined as deep confined with the aquifer to be reached at approximately 320 feet. Yields of other wells are not known.


