On my machine when I export as a *.prn, it chops off anything to the right beyond one page width. If yours does the same, that won't do. If it does, let's export all those files as comma delimited (only change the extensions to the Recharge Tool defaults). That might make Willem have to modify the code, I hope that is not too much trouble for him.

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I would recommend the csv format, I've found it to be most reliable. The only thing you have to be a bit careful of is the "save as shown" which sometimes drops a bunch of significant digits, but mostly it works best and has the fewest limitations.

We'll make mkmod work with whatever you need to do, so don't worry about that.
