1) Introductions/Attendance:

2) Geochemical Investigation presentation by the USGS (Candice Adkins).

Candice presented some preliminary results from the geochemical investigation conducted in the North Ada County study area. Results of CFC's, tritium, and general water quality parameters were discussed. Recommendations for additional source water sampling, additional age dating, and geothermal investigations were presented. Final report was anticipated to be ready by the end of August, 2010.

3) Geophysics Investigation presentation by CGISS (Lee Liberty)

Lee presented the preliminary findings of geophysical work conducted in north Ada and east Ada counties. Work efforts included seismic reflection using both hammer source as well as a vibroseis vehicle. Gravity and magnetic data was collected and compiled in both study areas as well. Recommendation for additional data collection was presented. Final report is predicted to be available by the end of the summer, 2010. The presentation is available on the NAC website.

4) Updates on current work tasks (Dennis Owsley)

Updates were presented on various tasks currently underway for the North Ada County project. Updates included drain and surface water measurements, the USGS stream gaging task, the Boise River seepage investigation, monitoring well installation for the City of Eagle, and water level monitoring network status.
