RE: Idaho Recreational Dredge Authorization (LETTER PERMIT)

Dear Dredger:

The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) hereby issues a general LETTER PERMIT. This LETTER PERMIT allows the Permit Holder, indicated below, authorization to operate a recreational dredge as described in the document "IDWR Recreational Dredging Program Instructions for 2010" dated March 19, 2010. This authorization is administered under the Stream Channel Alteration Rules, IDAPA 37 Title 03 Chapter 07 dated July 1, 1993 (Rule 64), and the IDWR Recreational Dredging Program Instructions for 2010 referenced above. The Special Conditions listed below also apply. Failure to adhere to these requirements can result in legal action as provided for in section 42-3809 and 42-1701B, Idaho Code.

Special Conditions:

- [1] This permit may be canceled at any time that it is determined that such action is necessary to minimize adverse impact on the stream channel.
- [2] The permit holder or operator must have a copy of this permit and evidence that required fee has been paid at the site where recreational dredging equipment is being operated and available for inspection at all times.
- [3] This permit does not constitute any of the following:
 - a. An easement or right-of-way to trespass or work upon property or mining claims belonging to others.
 - b. Other approval or permits that may be required by Local, State or Federal Government.
 - c. Responsibility of the IDWR for damage to any properties due to your operations.
- [4] All fuel, oil, and other hazardous materials shall be stored and equipment refueled away from the stream channel to ensure that a spill will not enter the waterway. No petroleum products shall enter the stream when servicing the equipment.
- [5] This permit shall expire March 31, 2011.
