Dear Director Tuthill,

This letter is a follow-up to provide you an answer to a question you asked me at our hearing. I testified as to the drop in water level in my well during Eagle's pump tests and to the similarities of my particular circumstances to Parker v Wallentine. You inquired of me if I had presented the documentation at the hearing. I replied that I did. This letter is to give you the exhibit numbers of that data.

My exhibit started with number 500 or 501 and went to 510 or 512 (as well as I can remember). All of the documentation for the water level drop would have been within these numbers. The were from SPF Engineering Firm, Hydrologic Inc. and Adam's Well and Drilling Company in Nampa.


In addition, I included duplicate information in my letter to the hearing officer for reconsideration to the Preliminary Order. The hearing officer had also asked, in the Preliminary Order, for similarities to our own case and Parker v Wallantine. I included them in that letter.

I sent an additional response, reiterating the same information in a letter of reconsideration to the Amended Preliminary Order. So in all, the DWR has at least 3-4 copies of the documents showing a dramatic drop in well water levels during Eagle's pump tests and the similarities of my circumstances to Parker v Wallentine.

Incidentally, for the past month fire hydrants on the property in question, for these protested water rights, have been pumping water into the air during most of the day - day after day. We have been told by United Water people that they are not supplying any water to this site. It appears the City of Eagle is pumping water from a right they do not have. This has been one of our major concerns from the beginning. We, as neighboring water right holders would like to know where this water is coming from and who holds the right to pump from this aquifer.

We appreciate your help and consideration on this very important matter.
