**IMPORTANT: A response from you is required to maintain the active status of the above referenced water right permits. If no response is received from you, these permits will lapse and your authorization to develop and/or use these water rights will be cancelled.**

Dear Permit Holder(s):

One of the conditions of approval of the above referenced water permits was that proof of the extent of your beneficial use must be submitted to this office on or before **November 12, 2015**. Please complete and return the enclosed Statements of Completion for Submitting Proofs of Beneficial Use (proofs) if you have completed the water projects authorized by your permits. The proof statements must be accompanied by either the appropriate license examination fees or field examination reports prepared by a certified water right examiner.

If you have not fully completed your projects, and you or a previous owner of these permits have not received a prior extension of time, you may request an extension of time if the delay is for reasonable cause as provided in Section 42-204, Idaho Code. If you have been delayed by a government agency or by litigation that brings title to the water in question, an extension of time may granted if appropriate documentation is provided at the time of filing. The extension requests must be accompanied by a \$50.00 filing fee for each permit and signed by the appropriate authorized permit holder(s) or authorized representative with a power of attorney.

Either acceptable proofs or acceptable extension requests must be received by this department on or before the above proof due date. If neither is received, the department will send you a lapse notice and the permits will no longer be of any force or effect.
