Michele,

The following is Terry's response to your POD overlap question:

There are two separate water systems serving the Willowbrook Estates.

- The domestic system supplies potable water for domestic use (i.e., in home use and irrigation of up to ½ acre on residential lots) and irrigation use (i.e., irrigation of common areas and those portions of residential lots exceeding ½ acre). The domestic system is supplied from three wells.
- The agricultural system provides non-potable water from wells for irrigation of agricultural lands and large common areas. The agricultural system is supplied by four wells.

The domestic system and the agricultural system are not physically connected.

- Both systems supply irrigation water under water rights 63-3079, 63-7131A and 63-8376E.
- Only the domestic system supplies water under 63-31862 and 63-12125.

The two wells in S28 and S29 are also listed on irrigation rights 63-3079, 63-7131A and 63-8376E as well as associated domestic right 63-12125. The irrigation rights are used for ag acres and subdivision common areas. The reason that the two domestic wells are also listed on the irrigation rights is because the domestic system is used for irrigation of lawn areas greater than ½ acre associated with large subdivision lots. The domestic system and the ag system are not physically connected.

I had a quick phone conversation with Lori a few moments ago.

I am nearing the end of my processing on this license. I have generated a first draft of the licensing amendment. As I understand your narrative, the 3 wells/points of diversion are for the domestic system only appropriate to rights 63-31862 and 63-12125. The irrigation water rights 63-3079, 63-7131A and 63-8376E are named in the field exam report as sharing the points of diversion for the domestic well system. But backfile information suggests that there are separate wells dedicated to irrigation use. Please confirm that for me.
