


On March 24, 2006, pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1411(3), the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources filed a *Director's Report* recommending general provisions applicable to water rights in Basin 69. The only general provision recommended by the Director in Basin 69 is the connected sources (conjunctive management) general provision.

A review of the Court's files and records reveals that no objections have been specifically filed to the general provision portion of the Basin 69 *Director's Report*. Additionally there are currently no unresolved subcases in Basin 69.

On February 27, 2002, Judge Burdick issued a *Memorandum Decision and Order of Partial Decree* in Basin Wide Issue 5 (Connected Sources General Provision), subcase 91-00005. Therein, Judge Burdick decreed the form of the conjunctive management general provision to be used in each administrative basin within the Snake River Basin Adjudication. This Special Master finds that connected sources general provision recommended in the Basin 69 *Director's Report* is consistent with the *Order* issued in Basin Wide Issue 5.

In accordance with the foregoing, IT IS RECOMMENDED that the Basin 69 general provisions be **decreed** as set forth in the attached *Recommendation for Partial Decree Pursuant to I.R.C.P. 54(b) for General Provisions in Basin 69*.





BASIN 69 GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources recommends to the Snake River Basin Adjudication District Court that the following general provisions be included in the decree determining rights to water from Basin 69.

1. The following water rights from the following sources of water in Basin 69 shall be administered separately from all other water rights in Basin 69 in accordance with the prior appropriation doctrine as established by Idaho law:
