**UNITED WATER'S MOTION TO LIFT
STAY AND REQUEST FOR STATUS
CONFERENCE**

This is Applicant United Water Idaho Inc.'s ("United Water") motion to lift stay and request for status conference.

This proceeding, known as the Integrated Municipal Application Package ("IMAP"), was initiated by United Water on May 4, 2001. On December 18, 2003, the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("IDWR" or the "Department") issued his *Order Re Motion for Stay* ("Stay Order"). The *Stay Order* imposed a stay on virtually all aspects of the IMAP proceeding, pending issuance of partial decrees for United Water's water rights by the SRBA District Court.


Partial decrees have now been issued with respect to all water rights claimed by United Water. These decrees have resolved many of the issues initially presented by the IMAP. Accordingly, United Water submits this motion to lift the stay in this proceeding in order that any remaining issues not resolved by the partial decrees may be addressed.

United Water further requests that a status conference be scheduled. The status conference will provide the Department and the parties an opportunity to explore procedural issues implicated by the lifting of the stay.

Out of an abundance of caution, United Water has served all those listed on the service list attached to the Stay Order. This may be over inclusive as some parties have subsequently filed withdrawals of protest.
