



## IDAHO WATER RESOURCE BOARD Loan Program

The Idaho Water Resource Board Financial Loan program exists to develop and to financially assist in the development of the water resources of the State of Idaho through the construction of water projects. Projects eligible for financing include new construction or rehabilitation of existing water projects such as:

**COMMUNITY DRINKING SYSTEMS** – Wells, Storage, Delivery System and Contaminant removal systems.

**IRRIGATION SYSTEMS** – Irrigation Ditches and Canals, Delivery Systems, Storage, Irrigation Systems, and Drainage Systems.

The term on a loan can range from 5 to 30 years with the average term being 15 years. Interest rates as of 2011 are 6% for Community Drinking Systems and 5.5% for Non-Drinking Systems.

### WHO QUALIFIES TO APPLY FOR A LOAN

Water Delivery Entities Such As:

Canal Companies, Irrigation Districts, Ditch Companies, Local Improvement Districts, Homeowner Associations, and Municipalities.
