

Allan,

We have been having some difficulty with the espam.exe program while installing and running Practicum_One for the ESPAM GIS Recharge Tool v1.1. We are using ArcGIS 9.3.1 with Spatial Analyst and have installed the Developer extensions for Visual Basic as well as Access 2003. The error message we are getting is shown in the screen shot below.

The message appears after the program tries to read the espam.mdb personal geodatabase. The espam.mdb database is created when we run the program but it appears the ESPAM program cannot read the personal geodatabase or update any tables in the database. If we use the 'espam.mdb' database in the Practicum_One folder we get the same error message. An automation error to me generally means a missing library/dependency of some kind. Are we missing a VB 6 or Access runtime library that should have been distributed with the ESPAM application? Can you discern what other issues might cause this problem?

The version of espam.exe we are using has a date and timestamp of 1/13/2004 9:18 am. If there are more recent versions of key files or specifications that we should be using, could you please post them? Could you post a list of the versions of ArcGIS/Access/Visual Basic and any other requirements for the ESPAM v1.1 program?
