

## MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Status Conference Summary

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On May 10, 2011, I hosted a status conference to discuss Application 61-12095. Norm Semanko and Christian Petrich represented the applicant, Nevid LLC. Mike Creamer called on the phone to represent the protestant, Idaho Water Co. Applicant Cleveland Corder was not represented. Mat Weaver and I attended for IDWR.

Permit 61-12090 is for a nearby, related development. Nevid has drilled two wells in connection with Permit 61-12090. One is a 1000 ft. test well cased with 5" pvc. The other is an 1120 ft. production well cased at 20 inches on the surface and necked down to 10 inches below ground. Christian conducted a 96-hour pump test at 2000 gpm from the production well and monitored the response in the test well. He has not analyzed the data yet. Christian has also submitted a monitoring plan in connection with Permit 61-12090 and received comments back from IDWR.

Nevid has not filed its Water Supply Bank application to irrigate from the production well for Permit 61-12090. Christian would like to irrigate and monitor to see how long recovery takes at the end of the season, but Nevid may not be able to make arrangements in time.

We also discussed whether IDWR should consolidate hearings for Application 61-12095 and others in the I-84/Mayfield area on the issue of water supply. IDWR has not yet decided to consolidate or not.

Since the consolidation question is still undecided, we agreed to set a status conference for September with an eye toward a January hearing date. The parties acknowledged that the schedule could change if IDWR decides to consolidate.
