TO: THE ABOVE NAMED RESPONDENTS, INTERIM DIRECTOR GARY SPACKMAN AND THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES, AND THE PARTIES' COUNSEL OF RECORD IDENTIFIED ON THE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE; AND THE CLERK OF THE ABOVE ENTITLED DISTRICT COURT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. The above named appellants, A&B Irrigation District, American Falls Reservoir District #2, Burley Irrigation District, Milner Irrigation District, Minidoka Irrigation District, North Side Canal Company, and Twin Falls Canal Company (collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Surface Water Coalition", "Coalition", or "SWC"), appeal against the above named respondents to the Idaho Supreme Court from the district court's final *Amended Order on Petitions for Rehearing*, entered in the above entitled action on September 9, 2010, the Honorable John M. Melanson presiding.

2. The above named appellants have a right to appeal to the Idaho Supreme Court, and the order described in paragraph 1 is an appealable order pursuant to Rule 11(f), I.A.R.

3. The appellants' preliminary statement of issues they intend to assert on appeal, which under I.A.R. 17, does not prevent the appellants from asserting other issues is as follows:

- a. Whether the Director erred in failing to apply the constitutionally protected presumptions and burdens of proof by utilizing a “minimum full supply” or “reasonable in-season demand” baseline for determining material injury to the Coalition’s senior surface water rights.
- b. Whether the Director unconstitutionally applied the conjunctive management rules by excluding certain junior ground water rights from administration.
- c. Whether the district court erred in concluding that a hearing on a mitigation plan must be held prior to curtailment of junior ground water rights causing material injury to senior surface water rights.
- d. Whether the District Court erred by directing the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources to bifurcate the final administrative order, despite ruling that the Director must issue one final order.
4. No order has been entered sealing any portion of the record.
5. The Appellants request that the transcript of the administrative proceedings held

before the Idaho Department of Water Resources be made a part of the record on appeal. The Appellants currently possess a copy of the transcript, as it was previously prepared in conjunction with the district court’s judicial review of this action. 6. The Appellants request that the agency record, including the exhibits, be copied and sent to the Supreme Court.
